By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.57, dated 26.07.2015, registered under Sections 22 and 29 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that no recovery was effected from the petitioner. In pursuance of the order dated 24.08.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for

custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 24.08.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
