This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.112 dated 03.08.2014, registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 r/w Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Heard.

Vide order dated 21.08.2014, the parties were directed to

appear before the learned CJM/Illaq Magistrate, for getting their statements recorded. In compliance thereof, report of ACJM, dated 05.01.2015 has been received, wherein, it has been noticed that the parties have compromised the matter with the accused without any pressure, coercion or fear.

In view of the above and the law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**', **2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab, 2014 (6) SCC, 466**, this Court feels that no purpose would be served in keeping the proceedings alive.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.112 dated 03.08.2014, registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 r/w Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner(s).
