Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Dinesh, son of Dilbag Singh, resident of Sulchani, Tehsil Hansi, District Hisar, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 148, 323 and 324 read with Section 149, IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 313, dated 4.5.2015, registered at Police Station, City, Jind.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from HC Mahender Singh of Police Station, City, Jind, submits that in

compliance of the interim directions dated 29.9.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the material available on record, the present petition is allowed. The interim directions issued vide order dated 29.9.2015, are made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.PC.
