FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 11.9.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class Moga has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Arun Kumar as well as of complainant Sandeep Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure money dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.105 dated 26.06.2015 under Sections 406,420,506 IPC, Police Station, Dharamkot District Moga and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
