Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC to the petitioner Subash Shrivastava in case FIR No.110 dated 04.05.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 66(A) of IT Act registered with Police Station PGIMS Rohtak.

As per the allegations the main persons accused of leaking All India Pre Medical Entrance Test Examination, 2015 had purchased in large numbers of undergarments fitted with microchips and earphones used by the candidates while undertaking the entrance exam.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the Director of a company engaged in the selling of such goods under a proper licence and, therefore, merely by the fact of large number of

purchases by the main accused did not show any complicity of the present petition in the alleged crime. He further states that petitioner is in custody since 19.05.2015.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh states that on completion of the investigation challan has been presented.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the fact that since the investigations are over & conclusion of trial is likely to take sometime, no useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars. As such the present petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Rohtak.
