Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order passed by this Court on 20.10.2015, the petitioner joined the investigation and gave his specimen signatures but he asked the petitioner to give the specimen signatures of the complainant, which cannot be given by him. The application was also moved before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar, for obtaining signatures of the complainant, but the same was dismissed as withdrawn on 29.10.2015.

Learned State Counsel submits that the petitioner has given his specimen signatures and has also joined the investigation.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State Counsel, interim order dated 28.01.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.
