Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.' for short), seek quashing of FIR No.729 dated 17.12.2013 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-34, Chandigarh, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (Annexure P-14) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing the case at considerable length, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to raise all possible pleas available to them before the learned trial Court, at the appropriate stage of trial.

Permission is granted.
