Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.30 dated 05.03.2015, under Sections 323, 325, 341, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kurali, District Sahibzada Ajit Singh Nagar (Mohali).

As per the prosecution case, petitioner along with his co-accused had attacked the complainant on 05.03.2015 at about 11:30 PM. Petitioner was armed with an iron rod and had given blows with it on the right arm and head of the injured-complainant. Admittedly, injuries on the person of the injured-complainant were opined to be grievous in nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 12.03.2015. Challan

has already been presented in the Court and charges have been framed by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on the other hand has opposed the petition.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 12.03.2015 and challan has already been presented in the Court and conclusion of trial may take time, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar.
