Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case
FIR No.163 dated 5.8.2015 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at
Police Station Sector-14, Panchkula.

This Court vide order dated 26.8.2015 had granted interim bail
to the petitioner subject to his joining investigation and complying the
provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to
order dated 26.8.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Amarjit Singh,

submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage as the challan has been presented in the Court.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the complainant submits that there are serious allegations against the petitioner. He further submits that as other family members of the petitioner have already been admitted on bail, therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and even the challan has been presented in the Court, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 26.8.2015 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
