Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.82 dated 01.06.2015 under Sections 354, 354-A (2), 354-C IPC, Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner places reliance on the order dated 19.08.2015 passed by this Court in CRM-M-27518-2015 (Gurdev Singh Vs. State of Punjab and anr.), wherein notice of motion has been issued for 29.09.2015, in a petition seeking quashing of this very FIR on the basis of compromise between the parties, to contend that parties have arrived at an amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jagdish Singh, Police Station Lambi, Sri Muktsar Sahib, also fairly states that parties have arrived at an amicable settlement.

In view of the above, instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail pending subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

Disposed of, accordingly.
