Quashing of the FIR No.21 dated 26.01.2014 under Sections 452, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Lopoke, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and its consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 10.08.2014 (Annexure P-2), is being sought.

The FIR was registered on a statement made by Balraj Singh-respondent No.2/complainant alleging that on 21.01.2014, at about 10 O' clock, his brother-in-law Jodhbir Singh son of Balwinder Singh armed with hatchet and his father-in-law Balwinder Singh empty handed and maternal uncle of his wife namely Major Singh armed with baseball came to his house and after raising lalkara inflicted injuries on the complainant for having solemnised marriage with the daughter of Balwinider Singh.

During the pendency of the investigation, the matter has

been compromised by the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 22.08.2014, status report has been received from the Judicial Magistrate Ajnala and the statement of respondent No.2/complainant-Balraj Singh has been recorded to the effect that he has compromised the matter with the accused party and he has no objection if the present FIR is quashed. Statements of the petitioners have also been recorded to the same effect.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.21 dated 26.01.2014 under Sections 452, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Lopoke, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1), is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of qua petitioners.
