Petitioner is brother-in-law of the deceased. He has been arrayed as an accused on the basis of a second dying declaration made by deceased Paramjit Kaur.

It has been informed that the petitioner has joined investigation. Challan has already been presented. Next date of hearing before the trial Court is stated to be 26.10.2015.

Prima facie, the petitioner being husband of the sister-in-law posted in Army at distant place, his culpability and involvement will certainly be a debatable issue.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that petitioner will be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court on the next date of hearing. He would remain on bail against the said bail bonds during the

period of trial subject to the condition that he will not tamper with the evidence and brow beat or threaten the witnesses.

In case of any such violation, it will be open to the prosecution agency or the complainant to approach this Court for cancellation of the bail.
