Challenge in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to the order dated 21.3.2014 (Annexure P/4) whereby the petitioner has been summoned in a complaint case filed by the respondent under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

Notice of motion was issued on 22.08.2014 and the service upon the respondent was effected. However, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent despite the case having been adjourned on 4.12.2014, 27.2.2015. Even today also, no one is present on behalf of the respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that an amount of Rs.50,000/- was transferred in the account of respondent on 7.3.2014 and the balance amount of Rs.50,000/- was deposited in in the account of the respondent on 19.03.2014. In this manner, she

submits that claim of the respondent stands satisfied. Since no one has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent despite service and the contention raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner has not been controverted, this Court is left with no option, but to allow the present petition. Accordingly, order dated 21.03.2014 is set aside and the complaint is also dismissed.
