Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seek quashing of FIR No.54 dated 23.05.2013 under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Notice of motion was issued.
