This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.220 dated 12.07.2015 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana (Rural).

FIR was lodged on the basis of a complaint of Jashandeep Singh. He alleged that petitioner alongwith three co-accused had taken various amounts for sending him to New Zealand. Complainant parted with amount of ₹25 lacs as there was assurance of sending him abroad. During investigation, investigating agency recorded statement of 09 persons who stated that they had also given money to petitioner as he promised to send them abroad.

It appears that petitioner returned some money by way of cheques issued by his wife. Same, however, were dishonoured.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the considered view that petitioner is not entitled to discretionary relief of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
