By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.45, dated 29.06.2015, registered under Sections 307/323/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), later added Section 427 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54/59 of the Arms Act registered vide DDR No.28 dated 29.06.2015, at Police Station Rampura, District Bathinda.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 26.08.2015/28.09.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in

pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 26.08.2015/28.09.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
