Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.130 dated 30.10.2011, under Sections 452, 427, 506, 295-A, 380, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station C-Division, Amritsar City, District Amritsar on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2-complainant Jaspal Masih alleging that the petitioners had constituted an unlawful assembly and assaulted the complainant and caused damage to his house.

Parties were directed to appear before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

The matter having been amicably resolved, following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) R.C.R.(Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
