The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.71 dated 13.06.2015, under Section 379, IPC and Section 411, IPC added later on, registered with Police Station Cantt., Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

As per the allegations, the petitioner along with his co-accused were committed theft of building material like shuttering material, pipes, iron plates, iron rods etc. from the store of construction company.

Upon notice, learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Baldev Raj, states that in order to complete the chain of theft including previous thefts, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

After hearing learned Counsel for the parties, keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Hence, the present petition stands dismissed.
