SURYA KANT, J. [ORAL]

In this second petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case registered against him under Sections 148/452/307/427/149 IPC and 25/27 of the Arms Act.

The petitioner clearly misused the concession of bail and went abroad without seeking prior permission of the Court. He was declared 'proclaimed offender'. He has chosen to come back after years only when his co-accused has been acquitted on the basis of an alleged compromise with the complainant-victim.

As the facts would speak for themselves, the petitioner is not entitled to concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed. Dasti.
