Prayer in this petition is for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, endangered at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and further directing the official respondents not to harass the petitioners, or eliminate in any false criminal case at the instance of the private respondents.

On 28.11.2014, counsel for respondents No.4 and 7 has put in appearance and stated that the respondents had taken back petitioner No.1. On the request made by counsel for the petitioners, the matter was referred to the mediation for an amicable settlement.

As per the report of the mediator, petitioner No.2- Bikram @ Vikram son of Jagjeet Singh had not turned up at the time of mediation proceedings. The case has been sent back as

no efforts were made for an amicable settlement.

Since petitioner No.1 has gone back to her parents,
this petition is dismissed.
