Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case under Section 306 IPC on account of wife of the petitioner having committed suicide pursuant to the acts of abetment committed by the petitioner. It has been contended that the matter has been compromised.

Next date of hearing before the trial Court is 23.01.2015. The family members of deceased, who was compelled to commit suicide, do not seem to be appropriate persons to exonerate the culprit by compromising the matter. The petitioner may seek acquittal by expeditious disposal of the trial but grant of bail on the basis of compromise does not seem to be appropriate.

Dismissed.
