ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 512 dated 14.07.2015 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Karnal under Section 7/13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the voice sample was taken and challan has also been filed. He further contends that trial would take time and bail may be allowed.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that challan has been filed.

The petitioner was arrested on 17.07.2015. The investigation is over and challan has been filed. On the last date of hearing learned State counsel had informed that an application had been filed for taking voice sample. The voice sample has been taken.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take long time to conclude, the

petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail
on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
