Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 128 dated 31.10.2009, under Sections 406/498-A/344 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar SBS Nagar on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Rajinder Kaur alleging that she has been maltreated by the petitioners.

Statements of the parties have been recorded under the directions of this Court regarding matter having been compromised.

In view of said circumstances and following the judgments of **B.S. Joshi and others Vs. State of Haryana and another 2003 (2) RCR (Criminal) 888** and **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052,** the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise. It will be open to the petitioner to seek the release of passport or any other documents on the basis of FIR having been quashed.
