On the asking of Court, Mr. Y.K. Gupta, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar to look into the grievances of petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated 18.08.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
