The petitioner as a member of an unlawful assembly had allegedly fired a shot causing injury on the left thigh of complainant Gurjant Singh. One of the co-accused of the petitioner had allegedly fired a shot on the left thigh of Vikram Sharma. The injured witnesses Gurjant Singh, Vikram Sharma and Karamjot Singh have been examined. The said witnesses have not supported the case of the prosecution and not identified the petitioner.

I have gone through the statements of said witnesses.

In view of said witnesses having not identified the accused including the petitioner, petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
