Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 20 dated 03.09.2014 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 447, 448, 427, 511 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 448, 511 of IPC added later on, registered at Police Station NRI Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Dalbir Singh submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.02.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation but the original copies of two sale deeds pertaining to the property of the complainant which were in possession of the petitioner, have not been got recovered by her.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes, on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner shall get the fresh certified copies of both the sale deeds pertaining to the property of the complainant from the office of the Tehsildar concerned and shall hand over the same to the investigating officer within a period of three weeks from today.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 06.02.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. It is further clarified that if the petitioner fails to hand over the certified copies of both the sale deeds pertaining to the property of the complainant, to the investigating officer within a period of three weeks from today, the investigating/prosecuting agency as well as the complainant would be at liberty to move an appropriate application seeking cancellation of the anticipatory bail, which is being granted to the petitioner.

Disposed of accordingly.
