The petitioner/wife of the deceased-Harbans Singh is seeking the transfer of investigation of case of the suicide of her husband to some senior officials.

The deceased-Harbans Singh was employed with Kudos Chemical Limited, Village Kuranwala, Tehsil Dera Bassi (respondent No.8) and he had committed suicide by jumping in front of a running train on 30.09.2012. A Suicide Note dated 06.09.2012 was found from his pocket blaming the Manager of the Company (respondent No.5).

Separate replies have been filed by the DSP (Admn.), GRP, Punjab on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 and the Management/respondent Nos.5 to 8.

In the reply filed on behalf of the officials of the Management, it is stated that the deceased-Harbans Singh was working at the post of Assistant Plant Operator and was a habitual absentee. Various punishments had been awarded to him on account of his various periods of absence.

In the reply filed on behalf of the State, it has been specifically stated that a thorough enquiry was got conducted by the SHO, GRP, District Ajitgarh (SAS Nagar, Mohali) and the allegations of the involvement of the Management was found to be unfounded. The said report was examined up till the IGP level and was approved.

After hearing learned Counsel for the parties and in the light of the contents of the unrebutted averments of the written statements, this Court is of the opinion that no further orders are required to be passed. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved, she is free to seek her remedy in accordance with law before the Courts of competent jurisdiction.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.
