INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.34 dated 27.02.2013, registered at Police Station Mataur District Mohali, under Sections 302, 307, 427, 506, 148, 149, 120-B, 201 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for complainant appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned State counsel and learned counsel for complainant and have gone through the record.

From the record, this Court finds that the trial is complete and the case is fixed for defence evidence.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and the fact that the trial is already complete, I do not find any ground to grant the benefit of regular bail the petitioner.

Therefore, finding no merit in the instant petition, the same is dismissed.
