The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 for the quashing of complainant bearing Sessions case No.37, dated 30.07.2013, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, pending before the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran, along with all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.
