ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 115 dated 07.07.2015 registered at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana under Sections 376-D, 354, 506, 34 IPC.

FIR No. 0 was registered in Vijay Nagar Delhi which was later forwarded to Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana. The complainant was married to the son of the petitioner in February 2015. Allegations were levelled that the complainant was beaten up and there was demand of dowry of Rs. 10 lacs. Serious allegations were levelled against the Jeth. The petitioner had alleged that the father-in-law slapped on her chest while the mother-in-law threatened to kill her and had opened the gas cylinder.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only allegation for which he has been arrested falls under Section 323 or 354 IPC and the entire family had been arrested. He further contends that the petitioner is 63 years old and suffering from various ailments.

Learned State counsel informs that the challan was ready for submission. He also states that the husband was also arrested.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the Investigation is over and that the trial will take long time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate.
