TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for the issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to ensure that the petitioner is not harassed at the hands of respondent No.4 and she is not called repeatedly to appear before the Women Cell, Sherpur, Police Post Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh would apprise the Court that the matter has thereafter been investigated and the application filed by respondent No.6 has been verified. State counsel further takes a categorical stand that under such circumstances, the petitioner henceforth would not be called upon to appear before respondent No.4 in pursuance to the application that has been filed by Joginder Kaur widow of Baba Singh, respondent No.6.

In the light of such categorical stand having been taken on behalf of the State, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
