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**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.66 dated 03.11.2013 registered under Sections 302, 324, 447, 511, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that in this case the three petitioners and their husbands were implicated. He has further argued that even from the reading of the FIR it is clear that the petitioners have been named only to create pressure because the allegations were that they tried to sow wheat on the land of the complainant. He has further

argued that the husbands of the three petitioners are in jail and no useful purpose would be served by now taking the petitioners in custody.

Learned counsel for the complainant as well as the learned Additional Advocate General have pointed out that during the pendency of this case the petitioners have been declared as proclaimed offenders. In these circumstances, they should not be granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view the entire factual matrix, in my considered opinion, it would not be appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. However, in case the petitioners surrender before the trial Court on or before 22.01.2015 and move an application for regular bail the same be decided by the Court on merits within 2 days i.e. by 24.01.2015.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
