Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.91 dated 03.06.2014, under Sections 498-A, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Section 406 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kharar, District Sahibzada Ajit Singh Nagar.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 28.01.2015:-

"Notice of motion for 26.02.2015.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be

released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
- 3. That he shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court."*

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Gurnam Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 28.01.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
