The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.133 dated 08.7.2015, registered under Sections 307, 452, 382, 323,295-A, 148 & 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Division No.7 (Varadhman), Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 08.07.2015; the injured Amarjit Singh suffered three injuries which are simple in nature. He also submits that the husband of the petitioner – Jai Parkash also received one injury on the head. The complaint has been lodged at the behest of Amarjit Singh, who is a correspondent of a local newspaper 'Chardhi Kala'. No injury is attributed to the petitioner.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mohan Lal, has opposed the present petition on the ground that there were specific allegations against the petitioner

that she had pulled the beard of the complainant and trespassed his house.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 08.07.2015. The injuries allegedly received by the complainant are simple in nature. The petitioner has not caused any injury. There are four minor school going daughters of the petitioner, who are not able to go to school after her arrest, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, subject to her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
