By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.140 dated 6.12.2014, registered under Sections 380, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

On instructions from ASI Avtar Singh, learned State counsel informs that two buffaloes were recovered from the petitioner. She further submits that the petitioner in compliance with the order dated 28.1.2015 passed by this Court, has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation as nothing remains to be recovered from him.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.1.2015 vide which the petitioner was allowed interim bail is made absolute. He shall abide by the conditions as enshrined in Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
