Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 55, dated 15.02.2015 for offence under Section 3/4 Punjab Prohibition of Cow Slaughter Act, 1955, Section 11/59/60 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and 307 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sampla, Distt. Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the present FIR, which was registered at the behest of ASI-Sukhbir, Police Post Kharawar, Distt. Rohtak, there is no allegation against the petitioner and it is only on the basis of the confessional statement made before the

police official, the petitioner has surrendered before the learned Magistrate, Rohtak. He further submits that there is no other case against the petitioner and the provisions of Section 307 IPC are not attracted, as no injury has been caused to anybody. The cows and bulls were not meant for slaughtering.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Joginder Singh Dahiya, submits that though there is no injury on the person of police officials, but the petitioner has made his best efforts to cause injury. Now the case is fixed for prosecution evidence and one of the co-accused, namely, Aarif has been declared as proclaimed offender.

Considering the fact that no injury has been caused to any of the police officials and also the fact that the petitioner has surrendered before the learned Magistrate, Rohtak, the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rohtak.
