HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition and wishes to withdraw the same. However, he submits that taking into consideration the old age of the petitioners, who are otherwise parents-in-law of the respondent No.2-complainant, their personal appearance before the trial Court may be exempted unless it is otherwise necessary.

Dismissed as withdrawn. The petitioners are at liberty to move an appropriate application before the trial Court for exemption of their personal appearance during the pendency of the trial. The trial Court shall consider such request of the petitioners and exempt their personal appearance unless it is otherwise necessarily required.
