Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.597 dated 2.12.2013 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector-5, Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was on regular bail and has been appearing before the learned trial Court on each and every date of hearing. However, since he was not feeling well, he could not appear on 12.8.2015 because of which non-bailable warrants have been issued against him vide order dated 12.8.2015 (Annexure P-3). He further submits that petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the learned trial Court and the learned trial Court may be directed to consider the bail application of the petitioner, keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court that if the petitioner surrenders before it within a period of one week from today, his bail application shall be considered, keeping in view all the facts and circumstances of the case brought to its notice by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate order, at an early date.

Disposed of, accordingly.
