Learned State Counsel states that 02 other cases bearing FIR No.28 of 2011 under 21 of the NDPS at Police Station Garhshankar and FIR No.33 of 2013 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Garhshankar with recovery of commercial quantity of smack, have been registered against the petitioner. In the present case, out of 09 witnesses, 07 have been examined.

Keeping in view the fact that the recovery of smack from the petitioner is commercial which is on higher side in the present case as well as two other identical cases, and the trial in the present case is almost on verge of the completion, no ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
