Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.235 dated 14.09.2010, registered at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna, under Sections 498-A/406/506 of the Indian Penal Code, on the basis of compromise, along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

The parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded with regard to compromise and the trial

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Court was directed to send the report with regard to validity of compromise, if any, effected between the parties.

Vide letter dated 01.11.2014, the trial Court has submitted report that there is no voluntary compromise on the part of the petitioners but the same appears to be a compromise under the coercion and against the wishes of the petitioners.

In view of the report submitted by the trial Court, instant petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioners will be at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.
