The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.58 dated 07.06.2015, registered under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') at Police Station Lahori Gate (Division No.4), Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused, Raja, Salim, Kavita and Mangal, have already been granted anticipatory bail. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner, who has been impleaded only on account of the fact that he is brother-in-law of Priya. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Heard.

The petitioner is specifically named in the FIR. The allegations against him are of harassing the daughter-in-law of the complainant. The offence alleged is of serious nature. This Court feels that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary in the matter. Therefore, no case for grant of relief sought is made out.

Dismissed.
