This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.65 dated 10.05.2015 under Sections 377, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Chatiwind, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR was lodged after delay of two months. Petitioner is in custody since May 11, 2015. According to him, except petitioner two other accused are juvenile.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that allegations are serious.

However, keeping in view the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner and period of incarceration of the petitioner, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
