Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.165 dated 01.04.2015 (Annexure P/1), under Sections 420 and 498-A, IPC registered at Police Station Manimajra, U.T., Chandigarh on the basis of compromise.

The FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2, Mona Sharma alleging that she was married to petitioner No.1 who had in connivance with other accused tortured and maltreated her.

Parties have now entered into compromise.
Statements of the parties have been recorded.

It is not out of place to mention here that criminal case has been registered only against petitioner No.1. Since the complainant by appearing before the Illaqa Magistrate has stated that the matter has been compromised and that she does not intend to pursue her case against all the petitioners, this petition

can be allowed subject to the fulfillment of terms and conditions of the compromise. A sum of Rs.75,000/- is required to be paid today.

Learned counsel for the complainant has received a sum of Rs.75,000/- in cash with an undertaking that the same shall be handed over to the complainant who is on her way to the court.

In view of above circumstances, following the judgment of Full Bench of this Court in case ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2007(3) RCR (Crl.), 1052***, this petition is allowed. The above said FIR and all the subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to condition that receipt signed by respondent No.2, Mona Sharma having received Rs.75,000/- will be made part of the record, today.
