Reply on behalf of respondent No. 1-State filed in Court, which is taken on record.

Pursuant to the order dated 26.8.2014, passed by this Court, report of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, received to the effect that the statements of the parties have been recorded. It is further reported that the parties have entered into a compromise.

In this case, two of the accused are stated to be dead.

Since the parties have amicably settled the dispute, therefore, FIR No. 315, dated 25.10.1992, registered under Sections 452, 506, 148, 149, 323 IPC at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana (Annexure-P-1) alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom stand quashed.
