Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to official respondents to arrest the accused involved in FIR bearing No. 28, dated 04.03.2015, for offence under Sections 376-D, 452, 386, 508 IPC and Section 4 of Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station, Division No.2, Pathankot, who has been declared a proclaimed offender in the said FIR.

The present petition has been filed without making any representation to the police authorities.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of at this stage, however, with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse of filing a representation before the police authorities. In case, representation is filed within one month, the authorities shall take appropriate action in accordance with law.
