Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.576 dated 18.04.2014, under Section 135 of the Electricity Act, registered at Police Station I & P, Hisar, District Hisar.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has deposited 30% of ₹6,66,620/- as assessed by the Electricity Board,

leaving aside the compoundable charges.

Vide order dated 23.03.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from ASI Inder Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 23.03.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
