Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.343 dated 06.10.2013, under Sections 307 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kotwali Faridkot, District Faridkot.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 27.08.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the parties have amicably settled their dispute and have filed a petition seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise.

Notice of motion for 22.1.2015.

List along with CRM-M No. 95 of 2014.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Satpal Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 27.08.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
