INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.88 dated 18.06.2013, registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 380, 454 and 506 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The FIR has been registered on the allegations that the petitioner alongwith co-accused Harjit Kaur and nephew of Harjit Kaur entered into the 'haveli' of complainant and committed theft of motor and pipes of tube-well. The co-accused Harjit Kaur has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court. The petitioner has joined the investigation. She is no more required for investigation or interrogation purposes. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the merits of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the order dated 29.01.2015, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
