Learned State counsel submits that the matter has been enquired in detail by the police and the suicide note of deceased has been found as genuine. In the complaint Annexure P-6, the complainant has levelled specific allegations and has given evidence in support of his contention.

As per the allegations levelled in the complaint, the pond, where the deceased Joban Singh has allegedly committed suicide, was having depth of only 4½ feet. It was also alleged that the hands and legs of the deceased were lying tied when the dead body was taken out.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3 to register FIR and entrust the investigation to some Gazetted police officer.
