Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner-Joginder Singh in case FIR No.228 dated 07.12.2012 for offence punishable under Section 22 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

As per allegations recover of 100 grams of intoxicant powder which, as per report of the Chemical Examiner, was found to be commercial in nature.

It is stated that the petitioner was granted regular bail under Section 167(2) Cr.PC for non filing of challan within stipulated 180 days and thereafter he was regularly appearing before the trial Court till his absence on 28.01.2015. Due to non appearance his bail bonds were

cancelled and non bailable warrants issued.

By relying upon certificate (P-1) it is submitted that the petitioner is drug addict and has been admitted in Rehabilitation Center from 28.11.2014 to 3.2.2015 due to which reason he could not appear on 28.01.2015. It is further stated that non appearance was not intentional and there is no other case pending against the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner surrendered before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail on 09.09.2015.

In view of the above, interim bail/protection granted by this Court vide order dated 31.08.2015 is hereby confirmed.
